Proverbs 31:10-31

POSITION:

Mother – may be referred to as Mum/Mummy/Mama/Poo poo head depending on client's mood, & Bruh.

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Team players needed for this challenging role in a crazy manic environment. Candidates must have excellent communication skills and be willing to work very flexible hours, this will include evenings and weekends plus all-night shifts. The primary responsibility is to nurture, guide, and protect children while managing all aspects of household operations.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Childcare & Development:** Providing 24/7 care, nurturing, and emotional support. Leading by example, disciplining, teaching values, and fostering a "growth mindset".

SKILLS:

- any previous experience with babies, toddlers, kids and teens, negotiating skills desirable;
- Organizational skills – skills of administrator required, able to keep track of several schedules (school, work, medical, social, personal) for multiple people
- Medical skills- basic medical knowledge needed, able to treat common cuts and wounds while offering compassionate counseling to the patients.
- Resilience – must be willing to be disliked, able to withstand verbal abuse and name calling, at least on a temporary basis and must be willing to bite tongue repeatedly;
- Bribery – experience with the Mafia would be an advantage.
- Maintaining the physical home- knowledge of basic home repair, able to work with contractors.
- Negotiation and psychological warfare skills a plus.

POSSIBLE PROMOTION:
